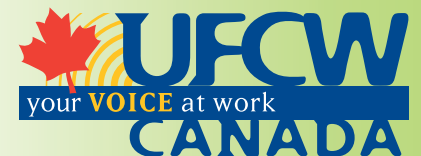

Every day UFCW Canada members are involved with various charitable events and organizations throughout the country. The most notable charitable work done by UFCW Canada and its members is fundraising efforts for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada.

Since adopting the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada as its charity of choice in 1984, members of UFCW Canada have raised more than \$6,000,000 for leukemia research. In 2006, UFCW Canada members raised more than \$1,100,000!

To further our fundraising efforts in new and inventive ways for leukemia research, the National Youth Committee (NYC) is asking you to take the challenge!

UFCW Canada and the NYC are issuing a challenge to all local union youth committees to see who can raise the most donations for leukemia research. The Leukemia Fundraising Challenge calls for all local union youth committees across the country to organize and participate in events to raise money for this important cause.



The local union youth committee which raises the most money, on a per capita basis, will be presented with a plaque from national president Wayne Hanley, receive a gift of thanks, and have the ultimate bragging rights!

This is a fantastic opportunity for all local unions to get their youth, and members, directly involved in a cause that is constantly in need of support and donations.

Since 2005, UFCW Canada local unions continue to rise to the challenge, and they are not only raising money, but also helping members get involved and interact with one another; building a sense of community within the union.



The Rules

- *Only monies raised from events that are organized by youth and implemented by the youth of your local union youth committee will be eligible for submission.*
- *The event runs from January 1 until December 31. Only monies raised during this time-frame will be accepted.*
- *Your submission must outline how much money was raised and include a description of each event in which it was raised. The leukemia fundraising challenge form can be downloaded at: www.ufcw.ca (under "Youth/Leukemia Challenge").*
- *All money must be submitted through the local union and received by local union president or secretary-treasurer.*
