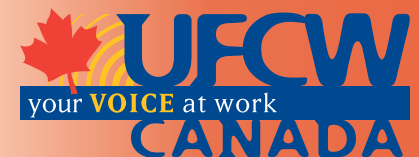

## UFCW Canada "Working Together Grant" (WTG)

### What is it?

*Introduced in 2003, the very successful Working Together Grant (WTG) winners have been increasing youth involvement through their own efforts and achievements.*

*The National Youth Committee will again be awarding five more WTGs. In the past, the grants have funded projects that were quite unique; ranging from youth social activities, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada fundraising, and educational events.*

*However different the projects were, each was successful in involving young members and highlighting UFCW Canada's commitment to young members within the union.*



*Being a young member of UFCW Canada has a special importance because it is the youth of the union who have the power to build solidarity and strength within the labour movement. If you, or your group, have an idea that continues this mission, the Working Together Grant is here to help you.*

*The goal of these projects and the grant money should be to raise the awareness of young members, create involvement, and give a sense of unity; while also publicizing UFCW Canada.*

*The grant is a great opportunity to raise money for leukemia research, a cause that UFCW Canada strongly supports. We recently set a new record for the largest annual donation ever made to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada!*

### Who can receive the WTG?

*Five (5) grants of \$1,000 will be awarded to members of UFCW Canada or UFCW Canada local youth committees who submit their application before the deadline of September 1. Successful applicants will be notified by October 1, through their local union president.*

### Applying for a WTG - The Basics!

- The grant is open to all UFCW Canada members or local union youth committees
- Applicants must submit a proposal no longer than two pages
- The proposal must include your name, local union, project ideas, and why you want to make your project happen
