RE: Human Rights

Policy HR-1

Approved Date: November 12, 2007

This policy shall apply to the National Council and its affiliated local unions.

UFCW Canada believes that every individual is entitled to certain inalienable human rights to pursuit of a more equitable, healthier, socially and economically just society for all. These rights include:

- The right to organize and bargain collectively
- The right to a living wage
- The right to an accessible post-secondary education
- The right to affordable day care
- The right to be free from discrimination
- The right to an adequate publicly-funded pension
- The right to high-quality universal healthcare
- The right to be free from harassment
- The right to clean drinking water
- The right to clean air
- The right to nourishing food
- The right to affordable housing
- The right to be treated with respect and dignity

This Council and its affiliated local unions shall support and encourage initiatives that promote human rights.
